POSITION SUMMARY:

Youth Ambassadors conduct outreach to community members, plan CLIC events, and work collaboratively in teams to promote the interests of the Cape Verdean Community publicly. All Ambassadors attend training and meetings Monday through Friday for the duration of the Cabral Youth Leadership Academy.

REPORTS TO:

- Youth Ambassadors will report to the Coordinator of Pro Success Programs

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Plan and assist with implementation of community events
- Plan and facilitate meetings with community partners
- Conduct regular outreach to community members
- Attend all Youth Leadership Academy trainings, meetings, and events early enough to be prepared to work at the start time
- Complete all requirements of the Youth Leadership Academy including but not limited to writing a resume, delivering a speech, conducting door-knocking, hosting meetings with peers, and other responsibilities as assigned
- Will be trained in events organizing, public speaking, career and college preparation, and leadership trainings
- Make available all documentation collected through community events/meeting
- Act as a role model to other youth program participants
- All other duties as assigned

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be able to acquire and demonstrate appropriate work behavior including attendance, focus on job tasks, ability to follow through with instructions.
- Must maintain good school attendance and performance and have a disposition and capability to work well with youth of diverse backgrounds, receive constructive criticism from and work with adults, and invest in own personal growth and professional development.
- Must have or be willing to work on developing strong written and oral communication skills
- Must demonstrate integrity and professionalism
